

ELIGIBILITY AND WEIGHTS CALCULATION - CONVERSION OF IRISH PTP PERFORMANCES

For the purposes of determining eligibility and the calculation of penalties, the Point to Point Authority have deemed that the following conversions will apply to performances in Irish Point to Points:

A 'Winner of One' race in Ireland is deemed to be a Restricted Race

A 'Winner of Two' race is deemed to be an Intermediate race and a winner of such race will therefore carry a 5lb penalty if entered in an Intermediate race in Great Britain. (NB. should the horse win this Intermediate then it will be ineligible to run in another)

A 'Winner of Three' race is deemed to be an Open race, and as such a winner of such race will carry the relevant penalty for an Open win in Great Britain.
