REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS

(OWNERS SHOULD NOTE THE FOLLOWING)

1. REGISTRATION OF HUNTER CERTIFICATE - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

By signing and submitting the Hunter Certificate for registration, signatories certify that:

- a) The details of age, sex and pedigree are correct and that the horse's name is registered under the Rules of Racing.
- b) The Master's declaration on the certificate is correct and that the horse is owned by a Master, Member, Subscriber or Farmer with the said Hunt and is qualified to be entered for any Hunter Steeple Chase run under the Rules of Racing and any race run under the Point-to-Point Regulations for which it is eligible.
- c) The horse has been residing in Great Britain for 7 clear days prior to the lodging of the Hunter Certificate, and will continue to reside in GB for the purposes of running in point-to-point races and Hunter Chases thereafter.
- d) I/We agree to be bound by the British Horseracing Authority Point-to-Point Regulations or part thereof currently in force.

Register in plenty of time. This is particularly important if you are registering a horse to run from 5th November 2023 onwards and in particular over the Christmas period.

TO BE ENTERED IN A POINT-TO-POINT STEEPLE CHASE (other than Hunt Members races held under Regulation 72) the Certificate must be registered by noon on a Thursday to qualify the horse for entry for meetings whose entries close on or after the following Saturday. Please note earlier registration dates for meetings staged during the Christmas period. Please refer to the National Planner.

TO BE ENTERED IN HUNTER STEEPLE CHASES the Certificate must be registered by noon the day before entries close (normally 6 days prior to the race meeting except for race meetings on a Saturday, which will normally close 5 days prior).

However, it should be noted that registration will not occur on a Saturday, Sunday, Bank Holiday, Good Friday or Christmas Day but by noon on the first day thereafter that the Equine Services Office is open for business.

2. REGISTRATION OF NAME

This Certificate cannot be registered until the Name of the Horse is registered under the Rules of Racing. If you are in any doubt as to the identity of this Horse, please contact the Names & Passport Section, Equine Services, Weatherbys, Sanders Road, Wellingborough, Northants, NN8 4BX, before completing this form.

N.B. There is no necessity for either Names registration or Hunter Certificate registration to be affected if horses are to be entered and run solely in Hunt Members races but owners must submit the Hunter Certificate to the Point-to-Point Secretary with their entry for this race.

3. PASSPORTS

The owners of all horses running in Hunter Steeple Chases and Point-to-Point Steeple Chases will be required to produce a Passport for inspection on the course. Please check that your horse has been correctly vaccinated in accordance with the conditions laid down in Regulations 35 and 36 of the Regulations for Point-to-Point Steeple Chases.

4. **HUNTER CHASES**

For entry in Hunter Steeple Chases (not Point-to-Point Steeple Chases) all owners must be on the Register of Owners and have Racing Colours officially registered.

If you intend to make entries for Hunter Steeple Chases you will require a login to the BHA Racing Administration website. Please apply on line at www2.racingadmin.co.uk or contact the Web Support team, Racing Operations, Weatherbys.

5. OWNERS' RESPONSIBILITY

Unless the horse has been placed in the care of a Keeper, the Owner will always be the person responsible for the care and training of the horse, and the ongoing compliance with the Rules and Regulations. Where the horse is placed with a Keeper the responsibility passes to the Keeper (as if the Owner) unless the Keeper can show that any breach was the result of an action by the Owner, to which they were not a party, in which case the responsibility will remain with the Owner.

Owners that continue to take responsibility and act for themselves are strongly advised to consult the current Regulations and, before making entries, to check all relevant details contained in the Point-to-Point Race Planner. They should also ensure that any third party acting on their behalf at a meeting is familiar with and aware of their responsibilities under Regulations 111(i), 141 (i), 115 (iii) & (v) and 118.

Owners are informed that should any of their horses running in Point-to-Point races consistently fall, unseat or show unruly behaviour they may have their Hunter Certificate suspended for the remainder of the season. The performance of all horses is monitored, and Owners will be contacted if a Hunter Certificate suspension is being considered.

6. Owners should note that where a horse moves to a new Keeper, a Change of Keeper form must be completed and, if the Keeper has not already done so, the Keeper signed to agree to be bound by the Rules and Regulations.

The form can be found on the point-to-point website under Guides and Downloads.

7. ENTRIES

It should be noted that the ability for a Keeper to make entries is an extension of the powers given to the Keeper by the Owner, so as the Keeper can act on their behalf; it does not prevent an Owner from continuing to make their own entries by other means or acting for themselves at a meeting.

8. DEFRA HORSE PASSPORTS REGULATIONS

Under EU Regulations, to be considered valid by DEFRA, a horse passport must contain certain pages including the declaration pages necessary to declare whether the horse is destined for human consumption – or not. Failure to have a valid passport for a horse is an offence under these regulations. We strongly advise you to check for the presence of the necessary pages within the passport. A fee of £24 will be due to Weatherbys for each set of pages issued. The BHA advise that horses are declared not for human consumption to allow a full range of medicines to be used.

9. POINT-TO-POINT AUTHORITY HORSE SPONSORSHIP SCHEME (HSS)

In order to enjoy the benefits of the HSS, the business name of the sponsor (maximum 45 characters including spaces) must be added to this Hunter Certificate or subsequently registered with a HSS1 form. The business name may NOT appear in any racecard nor on any paddock sheet until this registration is confirmed (in a letter from Weatherbys) and the appropriate fee (£60 inc. VAT) has been paid. If you would like to register a multi-horse sponsorship – which has differing price bands depending on the number of horses sponsored – you will need to complete a HSS2 form (available to download at www.pointtopoint.co.uk) and return to the Point-to-Point Authority. **Please note** – you cannot be removed from the single-horse scheme (HSS1) once registered and no refund to the fee will be made if you subsequently register a multi-horse sponsorship (HSS2), which has slightly different conditions. 10. KEEPER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

By signing the Declaration and taking a horse into their care and training, the Keeper is accepting responsibility for compliance with and any possible breaches of the Rules and Regulations under the name of the 'Owner'. Where the Keeper can show that any breach was the result of an action by the Owner, and that they were not a party to the breach, the responsibility will remain with the Owner and any disciplinary action will be taken against the Owner.

Amendment to Regulations

DEFINITIONS

'Keeper' is a person to whom an Owner has passed the care and training of their horse and who, as the Keeper, becomes responsible for compliance with the Point-to-Point Regulations for Steeple Chases as if the Owner. No action will be taken against the Keeper where it can be shown that any breach of the Regulations was the result of an action of the Owner, to which the Keeper was not a party, in which case the Owner will be responsible.

11. PPORA RACES 2023/24 HORSE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

No horse shall be eligible to run in a PPORA Club Members' Point-to-Point Steeple Chase unless the owner is EITHER a current Life, Honorary, or 2023/24 Owner or Rider member of the PPORA by declaration of the horse on the day of racing.
