

Changes to Regulations for 2021-22 Season

Race Regulations

The 5lb penalty in Opens for 3 wins Under Rules in the previous season will now stop on 1 March each season. This brings it into line with introduction of Level 1 Conditions races on same date, and also recognises that that type of horse tends to be hunter chasing by that stage or have already got a maximum penalty.

Horse Eligibility

Regulations 32-34 are being rewritten to remove ambiguity. The three key points are:

- Hunter Certificates must be registered by the Thursday 1200 before Entries Open rather than the traditional Friday. This will reduce pressure on registering and allow entries to open by 1300 on Friday.
- Horses which in same season have point to pointed and then gone under rules may not return to point to pointing in that season.
- The trial of the 28 day rule for movement from Under Rules to pointing will be extended a further 12 months due to the disruption last season.

Horse Welfare

All horses which are 15 yo or more must have a vets certificate, stating that they are in condition to run safely, provided with their declaration form for their first run of the season.

Jockeys

Jockeys may only ride at one course a day, whether under Rules or point to point.

Miscellaneous

- **Stop Flag.** Point to point will now use the orange and yellow diablo flags as used Under Rules.
- **Declarations.** Declarations will now close 60 minutes before the race is due to run. Sheets to be pre-filled
- **Judges.** Regulations adjusted to ensure Judges have greater technological support

Registration of Keepers

A formal register of Keepers (including Owner-trainers) will be kept from this season coming. This is in line with recent changes in BHA policy re visits to yards, increasing public interest in Horse Welfare and fact that Keepers are recognised for issues such as sponsorship etc.
