### Amendment to PPORA Races Eligibility Criteria

As of Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January, in order to participate in PPORA Club Members Races, both the Owner and Rider must be a member of the PPORA by **declaration** of the horse on the day of racing.

The responsibility for checking/ensuring that current membership of the PPORA is in place lies solely with Owners and Riders.

Entry Fees will not be refunded for those found to be ineligible and any Owner or Rider found to have participated in a PPORA race whilst not eligible is liable to be fined and disqualified by BHA.

## QUALIFICATION FOR THE CHELTENHAM OPEN FINAL HUNTERS' STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 2)

Cheltenham May (Evening) Meeting, Friday May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020

Qualification for the Open Final Hunters' Steeple Chase at the Cheltenham Evening meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2020, has been amended so that all horses aged five yrs old and upwards which **have been placed in the first four in any Mens, Ladies or Mixed Open Point to Point Steeple Chase, during the current Point-to-Point season and prior to April 25th 2020, will be eligible to enter.**

ELIMINATION PROCEDURE – Horses who have finished in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> place in any Mens, Ladies or Mixed Open Point-to-Point Steeple Chase in the current season will be protected from elimination. Should it be necessary to eliminate some but not all horses with the same profile, random balloting will apply.

Cheltenham May (Evening) Meeting, Friday May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020

Qualification for the Intermediate Point-to-Point Championship Final Hunters' Steeple Chase at the Cheltenham Evening meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2020, has been amended so that **the first four horses past the post in any Intermediate point-to-point race during the current season (2019/20), with the exception of four-year-olds, will be eligible to enter.**
